I want to encourage you to press on! We continue to hear updates from people seeing God work in this. One person shared with us that she felt God leading her to pray for the salvation of a neighbor friend – God didn’t wait six months but that friend received Christ two weeks ago. That New Lifer is now trying to answer questions and help the person to keep moving forward spiritually.



If you are struggling with keeping consistent in praying daily, I’ve found it helpful to have reminders. In our house we have a Kenya prayer sticker on the bathroom mirror. Also, I keep prayer lists for the various matters and people I pray for each day, and I always make sure my Kenya prayer is written at the top. I also have a Kenya prayer magnet on my file cabinet. I’m trying to develop the habit of shooting a quick one-line prayer for my request whenever I see the sticker or magnet. I’m not always successful but seeing the reminders several times a day keeps this an active matter in my day to day life.

Remember what is prompting us to pray – Jesus said in John 14:13-14 “*I will do whatever you ask in My Name so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You can ask Me for anything in My Name and I will do it.*” Jesus gives us big promises to base our prayers on and we want to exercise faith in His words, and bring to Him those people and issues that really need miracles. As we turn to Him I think we’ll be amazed at what God does.
